## As Easy As

To relatives: "Jack, I have watched you all my life. You are not a church person. Maybe you do read your Bible; I don't know. But I love you and I want you happy ... forever happy. I have read in the Bible myself that one day Jesus is coming again. May I ask you something?"

To strangers on a Wal-Mart parking lot: "Sir, do you love Jesus? You do? Well, the Bible says Jesus is coming again. May I ask you something?"

To strangers in a worldly place: "I am taking a personal interview. Do you believe there is a God?" You do? "Then, do you believe the Bible is the Word of God? You do? Well, the Bible say Jesus is coming again, may I ask you this question ...."

To neighbors at their doors: "We are Christians trying to meet and help our neighbors. Do you know of anyone in need of food? Of clothing? Anyone lonely we could befriend? We are Christians and we want to make sure our neighbors are going to Heaven. May I ask you this question?"
